Dear Parents/Guardians,

Grace Academy Summer Camp is almost here! I hope that this letter will answer many of your questions.

### **WHAT TO BRING?**

First, each camper should bring a backpack every day with a dry set of clothes, towel, bathing suit, water bottle, packed lunch, 2 healthy snacks, sunscreen and sneakers. Please do not pack lunches that need microwaved on field trip days. **If your child uses a booster seat, please make sure the booster seat is left with the Camp teacher each day for field trips.**

### **WILL MY CHILD NEED MONEY?**

The cost for Kona Ice is \$2.00 (not \$1.00- misprint in the flyer) - Every Monday!

Slushies at Starland - \$1.00

Campers may want some extra money on days we go to the movies.

\$7.00 - (half of the cost) - per camper for the **Laser Tag Trip Only June 27**

**Please see the attached schedule for daily events/trips.**

The director has the right to change/modify the schedule as needed due to inclement weather. Parents will be notified of any changes.

All camps will meet in room 21 (the room right past the library).

All camps begin at 8:30 and end at 3:00. Before care cost is from 7:30-8:00 and

After care cost begins at 3:15-4:00. The cost of Before/After care is \$5.00 per day per camper.

### **How To Dress and Behavior Expectations:**

- **Jeans for Horseback riding June 20 at Star** - Jeans with an appropriate fit and no holes or tears or appropriate athletic pants
- Knee length shorts with an appropriate fit, no holes or tears.
- Closed toe sandals with strap or sneakers
- Flip flops permitted only for Pool Day
- Bathing suits - one piece for girls
- No t-shirts or shirts of any kind with vulgarity or inappropriate language or images. Sleeveless shirts are permitted but not thin straps.

- No inappropriate body piercings or tattoos.
- Hair must be natural in color.
- Hats and Sunglasses are allowed for Summer Campers.
- Campers are responsible for their own belongings and are encouraged not to share hats or sunglasses.
- Please label all of your child's belongings with their name.

**Summer Camp Expectations:**

Campers are expected to listen and show respect at all times.

Campers will be given age and action appropriate discipline as needed (3 Verbal Warnings before Time-Out). If the camper continues to disrupt, disrespect or cause physical harm or damage, parents will be called to pick up their camper. Disrespect, foul language, bullying and violence are not tolerated.

**If your child has allergies or needs medicine, it should have been listed on the registration form. Please make us aware of any health issues if you have not already!**
