



What is Scrip? And how does it benefit my family?

Scrip is an easy way to earn credit toward your child's tuition while you shop. You purchase gift cards at face value through Scrip and you spend the face value. Use Scrip gift cards instead of cash or credit when you shop in stores or online. Each company has a specific percentage rebate, which is then applied to your tuition.

The Scrip Program offers an additional financial assistance option to Grace Academy families, which will not require any additional spending. If planned and integrated well, a family could earn hundreds of dollars off their annual tuition.

Think and plan, “how much does my family spend each month on groceries? Eating out? Gas for each vehicle? Home repairs or upgrades?” Plan your monthly spending and where you shop. Then purchase your gift cards and spend them in place of cash or credit. You can find more information and planning tools on **ShopWithScrip.com** to help you and your family plan.

How to place a Scrip order

To order Scrip cards at Grace Academy to earn credit toward your child's tuition:

- Pick up an order form in the main office
- Complete and return it with check or cash to the Scrip drop box by the **second or fourth Friday of each month**
- Receive email confirmation of your order ready for pick up from the school office
- Spend your Scrip gift cards like cash and earn credit toward your child's tuition

Scrip rebates will accumulate each grading quarter and will applied to your tuition payment at the end of each quarter.
